## Fishing Tournament 2025

### Rules and Regulation

- Each Angler must pay the \$100.00 registration fees for the tournament in order to weigh your fish for the following categories: Red Fish, Speckled Trout and Triple Tail, Ladies, and Youth.
- All fish must be caught on September 6th starting at 12:01 am. The tournament scales will be open on Saturday, September 6th at 3:00pm and close at 6PM.
- Speckled Trout, Red Fish, and TripleTail may be entered if caught East of the West bank of the Mississippi River as it flows to the Alabama line. If caught outside the boundaries you will be disqualified. No two boats are allowed to touch at any point.
- Also; if Anglers are fishing LA waters; they can't stop in MS water until they've reached the harbor; unless it's an emergency.
- The Tournament will follow Mississippi guidelines. Any fish entered into the tournament must meet MS rules and regulations:

Triple Tail: 18" total length

Trout: 15" total length

Reds: 18" to 30" total length

- No fish can be caught by bicycle rigs, spears, traps, nets, or any other entangling device and will be disqualified. No harpoons. No snagging. No foul hooking. Bamboo poles are acceptable.
- We will have a ladies category for the biggest over all fish (Red Fish, Speckled Trout and Triple Tail)
- Youth Category will be 12 and under (Red Fish, Speckled Trout and Triple Tail)
- The heaviest fish will be the winner of each category. In case of a tie, the FIRST fish weighed in will be determined the winner.
- The tournament weighmaster or board member reserves the right to reject any fish entry because of poor conditions, mutilation, or frozen. The condition of the fish will be left up to the scrutiny of the weighmaster and/or committee. The decision is final.
- All fish weighed may be subject to random gutting. Failure to allow a tournament committee member to gut a fish will result in disqualification of the fish in question.
- All winners are subject to a polygraph at the discretion of the tournament board members. The protest must be made before the closing of the scales at 6PM on Saturday the 6th. If the polygraph is refused for any of the prizes, the fish will be disqualified!
